

SRO Executive Board Meeting Minutes 11/28/18

Meeting called to order

Jayson Zoller and Kris Laskey reported they attended a meeting recently about the Redbook. After the meeting, it was determined there are several areas where the SRO and its bylaws are not in compliance with Redbook.

One of the issues is that a school employee is not allowed to serve as the treasurer of a booster organization. SRO Treasurer Kris Laskey is employed as the Tennis coach at Highlands and has resigned her position because of the conflict. Laskey may remain on the board in another capacity, that has yet to be determined.

After much discussion about the best way to proceed, the board agreed to inform the membership about the issues and ask for a vote to allow the board to update the bylaws. This email will be sent in the next week or so. Also, included will be a request for nominations for treasurer to fill out Laskey's unexpired term.

Jason Burgess presented an update on the James and the Giant Peach production. All is going well. Colin Shadwell's 8th grade art students have completed three designs for the show. One will be used for programs, another for hoodies and the third for the poster.

David Veshapidze is inputting all the parent payment information for James and the Giant Peach. This is a cumbersome task and SRO may look for another way to set up payment at the parent meeting, so parents can input their own information.

SRO membership continues to grow with about 100 members currently. SRO received corporate sponsorship money in the mail.

A bill was received from Bill Poff for the DVD's for As You Like It. That will be paid in the next few days.
