

SRO Meeting Minutes 1/17/19

The Board met at Fort Thomas Public House.

President Jayson Zoller opened the meeting with an introduction of the new officers. A new treasurer has been appointed and two new board positions have been added. The new board positions and duties were explained.

President's Report:

The President and Treasurer are working with the bank to get new signatures on the accounts and complete the transition from one treasurer to another.

Fessler's and LaRosa's will be providing tech meals for James and the Giant Peach. Fessler's pizza is a donation as part of a corporate sponsorship. SRO will pay for the LaRosa's pasta meal.

The Board will soon be working to update the by-laws.

Treasurer's report:

Treasurer Billie Heilman reported she is just beginning in the treasurer roll, so she did not have a report this meeting, but she will provide regular monthly financial statements starting next month. She is also working to convert to a digital accounting system so reports will be available on the website. She will also be sure we are Redbook Compliant.
